Budget Workshop – 4/13/2021 MINUTES

The following is an account of the minutes taken at the Budget Workshop held on April 13, 2021 at 5:00pm at the Jamesville Town Hall Meeting Room 1211 Water Street, Jamesville, North Carolina.

Mayor Dennis Anton opened the meeting and asked Mayor Protem Willis Williams if he would say a prayer over the meeting

Discussion of the following items to be included in the GF Budget:

- Commissioner Larris Tolson moved to increase the Commissioners salaries to \$1,200.00 and Mayor's salary to \$1,500.00. Mayor Protem Willis Williams seconded. Motion unanimously passed. 5 Ayes – 0 Nays.
- Commissioner Larris Tolson moved to increase the Clerk's salary by 15.6% (6% COLA/ 9.6% Merit). Commissioner Carolyn Martin seconded. Motion unanimously passed. 5 ayes – 0 Nays.
- Commissioner Larris Tolson moved to increase the Finance Commissioner's weekly amount increased to \$40. Commissioner Carolyn Martin seconded. Motion unanimously passed. 5 Ayes – 0 Nays.
- The board discussed changes to the Employee's Health Insurance. Information was presented for the different options of coverage available. Commissioner Willis Williams moved to approve Option 1 – Med 1000 30/40 for the FY 21-22. Commissioner Carolyn Martin seconded. Motion unanimously passed. 5 Ayes – 0 Nays. The active employees will continue to pay 10% weekly for the cost of the Health Care Coverage.
- Commissioner Larris Tolson moved to change the salary percentage allocation for Wayne Thomas to 15% Powell Bill, 70% General Fund, and 15% Water/Sewer. The change was made due to the annual wages coming out of the Powell Bill account exceeded the amount that was received annually.
- The Tax Rate for the Town will remain at \$.70/\$100 of property valuation for FY 21-22.

Commissioner Larris Tolson moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:47pm. Commissioner Rachel Craddock seconded. Motion unanimously passed. 5 Ayes – 0 Nays.
